



ADMISSIONS PROCEDURE & TUITION FEES FOR INTERNATIONAL STUDENTS

ADMISSIONS PROCEDURE

To apply for admission to Brockton, complete the *Application for Admission – International Students* form and submit it to the school together with all required supporting documentation and the required Assessment Fee. Submission of an *Application* and the Assessment Fee does not guarantee admission to the school.

Applicants to Kindergarten must be at least 5 years old on December 31st of the year of entry to Brockton.

Admission to the school is determined on the basis of review of the *Application for Admission*, a review of the student's school transcripts, and (if possible) a personal interview with the student and parent(s) or legal guardian(s) and an in-person academic assessment. Upon successful completion of the assessment process, the school will issue a conditional acceptance, and the student must then pay 40% of the year's fees. Upon receipt of the initial 40% of fees, the school will issue an official letter admitting the student to the school and a letter for the Government of Canada Department of Immigration (for student visa purposes). The balance of the year's tuition fees will be due upon receipt of the official "Letter of Acceptance". A copy of his or her Student Visa must be provided to the school prior to the student's first day of arrival at Brockton School.

OPTIONS FOR INTERNATIONAL STUDENTS ATTENDING BROCKTON:

In Canada, the academic year starts in September and ends in June of the next year, with breaks in December and March. International students attending Brockton for a year have the option of attending Brockton for the normal Canadian school year of September to June, or they may choose to split their year at Brockton over the course of two consecutive school years, attending Brockton from January through June, and then continuing on from September through December. The school normally requires a minimum 1-year financial commitment from International Students.

* **ESL (English as a Second Language)** instruction is included in this tuition fee.

Student Activity Fee: Fees are shown above and cover textbooks, non-reusable books, all school supplies (with the exception of some materials required by students in the senior grades), the yearbook, and most field trips and activities.

PAYMENT OF FEES: 40% of the tuition fee is due upon successful completion of the assessment process when the school issues a conditional acceptance. The balance of the year's tuition fees, and the Student Activity Fee, will be due as soon as the school issues the official "Letter of Acceptance" to the student. For returning students, fees are due on March 1st of each year.



OTHER FEES & EXPENSES:

Assessment Fee: Applications for admission to the school must be accompanied by a non-refundable \$300 academic assessment fee (\$150 for applicants to Kindergarten).

School Uniform: The approximate cost is \$750. School uniforms are at Cambridge & Co. 1588 MacGowan Avenue in North Vancouver (south of Marine Drive, 5 blocks east of Capilano Road), telephone (604) 924-9309.

School Bus: Brockton runs a daily mornings-only school bus service that starts in Deep Cove. Details and costs are available from the school or our website. Additional school bus routes will be added as enrolment grows.

Outdoor School Camps (Grades 4+): Fees are charged at cost.

After-School Care: Brockton offers a licenced after-school care program for students in grades K through 5. Program information, including information on fees, is available from the school and on the school's website.

REFUND POLICY:

Assessment, Tuition, and Student Activity Fees are non-refundable. Fees for the After-School Care Program are refundable in certain limited circumstances as set out in the Parent Handbook for that program.
