ADMISSIONS PROCEDURE

To apply for admission to the school, please complete the *Application for Admission* form and submit it to the school together with all required supporting documentation and the required non-refundable Assessment Fee. Submission of an *Application* and the Assessment Fee does not guarantee admission to the school.

Applicants for admission to Kindergarten must be at least 5 years old on December 31st of the year of entry to Brockton.

Admission to the school is determined on the basis of review of the Application for Admission, a personal interview with the student and parent(s) or legal guardian(s), and an academic assessment. The methods of assessment used vary with the Grade level for which a student is seeking admission to the school, as follows:

For applicants to **Kindergarten**, students will participate in a one-on-one assessment with a teacher who will determine the child's current academic level and his or her readiness for the Brockton programme.

For applicants to **Grades 1, 2 and 3**, students will participate in a one-on-one assessment with a teacher who will determine the child's current academic level and his or her readiness for the Brockton programme. If school is in session, these students are invited to join their prospective classmates in the classroom for the day of their assessment.

For applicants to **Grade 4 and up**, students can join their prospective classmates for the morning and then complete a formal assessment in the afternoon of their visit.

Brockton asks all its applicants to spend a half or full day at the school in order to become more familiar with Brockton and its programmes. Please contact our Director of Admissions, Mrs. Mysia Gruber, for an appointment. We will do our best to accommodate your appointment preferences.
