The grade levels noted here refer to 2007/2008 grades. Enclosed with the Report Card will be a reading list for each student.

- PYP Reading List – Kindergarten to Grade 3 students
- PYP Intermediate Reading List – Grade 3 and 4 students
- MYP Reading List – Grade 5 to 8 students

We ask, as a minimum, that the PYP students (K – 3) read 14 books, PYP Intermediate students (3* - 4) read 3 – 5 novel length books and the MYP students read 2 novel length books.

Accompanying the reading lists will be a Reading Log for the PYP students and a Book Report form for the MYP students. Students should bring the completed forms back to school with them in September. In the event that your Reading Log or Book Report forms get mislaid over the summer we shall have extra copies in the office.

A resource not to be overlooked and which all of the libraries in British Columbia hold are books on CD and Audiotape. They can make even short car trips entertaining, enjoyable and informative. Many of the books on the Reading Lists are available in this format.
