** The above fees are dependent on the school receiving the per student operating grant from the Province of British Columbia. Where this grant is not received for a particular student, the student’s tuition fees will be increased by \$2,500 in lieu of the grant. In order to qualify for the provincial grant, a student’s parent(s) must be permanent residents of British Columbia and either a Canadian Citizen, landed immigrant or otherwise lawfully admitted to Canada.

A separate fee schedule applies for International Students, for whom a Student Visa from Immigration Canada is also required. Please contact the school or download an International Student’s package from our website for more information.

Payment of Fees: An initial installment of \$3,000 is due on March 5th. The balance of fees may then be paid in full by June 30th or in 10 credit card installments (July 1 – April 1). There is an administration fee of \$30 per installment for the extended payment plan. Installment payments may only be made by credit card (Visa/MasterCard). Post-dated cheques for installment payments are no longer accepted. Please note that payment by installment does not constitute a fractional commitment. Tuition for the full school year is payable whether payment is made in full or by installment.

Sibling Discount: The school provides a 5% discount on tuition fees for 2nd siblings. For 3rd and subsequent siblings the discount is 10%.

Tuition Fee Assistance: The school offers assistance to families with limited incomes by providing bursaries which cover up to 50% of tuition fees. Please contact the Head of School for more information.

OTHER FEES & EXPENSES:

Brockton Bond Programme Interest bearing contribution of \$20,000 per family with interest paid annually. Repayment made to the purchaser after the last child has left the school.

Application Fee: Applications for admission to the school must be accompanied by a one-time, non-refundable \$250 application fee.

New Student Registration Fee: This one-time, non-refundable fee of \$1,000 is required upon acceptance to Brockton Preparatory School. This one-time, non-refundable fee is not applied to tuition costs.

Student Activity Fee: The Activity Fee is due on June 30th. This fee covers textbooks, non-reusable books, all school supplies (for students in grades Kindergarten to 5), the yearbook, and most field trips and activities.

Outdoor School Camps (Grades 4+): Fees are charged at cost.

After-School Care: Brockton offers a licensed after-school care programme for students from Kindergarten to Grade 5. Programme information, including information on fees, is available from the school and on the school's website.

REFUND POLICY:

Application fee, New Student Registration Fee, Tuition, and Student Activity fees are non-refundable. Fees for the After-School Care Programme are refundable in certain limited circumstances as set out in the Parent Handbook for that programme.
